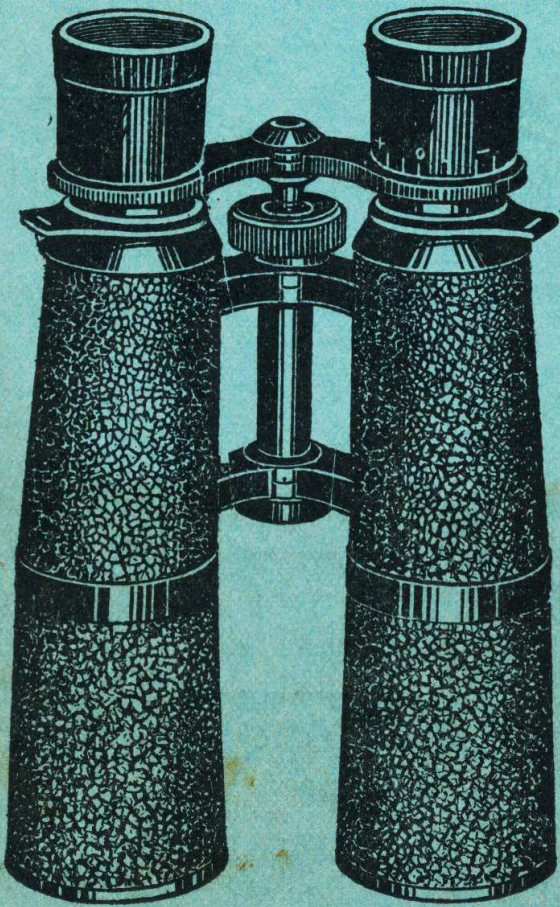

*Valuable Information to Consider
in the Selection of
a Binocular or Field Glass*

MB

IN the trade it is customary to designate a glass which does not contain prisms as a Field Glass.

A glass containing prisms is termed a Binocular. The prisms are inserted to increase the field of view. In our specifications on pages 39 and 40, you will find listed the field of view of each glass, given in measurement of yards at 1000 yards distance. The field of view given in each case is the diameter in yards of the scene covered by that glass at a distance of 1000 yards.

A question often asked is, "How far can one see with such a glass?" The answer is that you can see only as far with a glass as you can with the naked eye, that distance being the horizon. What the glass does is to magnify the object according to the power of the glass. This term "power" is usually designated by "x"; for example, a 6 power (or 6 x) glass will magnify the object 6 times, or in other words, make it appear 6 times nearer. An 8 power (or 8 x) glass, 8 times, etc.

The objective lens in a glass is the large lens farthest from the eye. The size of this lens is important insofar as it governs the amount of light allowed to enter the glass. The greater the percentage of light, the clearer the object. The measurement of the objective lens in a Binocular is always given in millimeters (mm.), thus a glass marked 8 x 30 is an 8-power glass with an objective lens of 30 millimeters diameter. (1" represents about 25 millimeters.) On Field Glasses the ligne measurement is often used. (There are 11 lignes to the 1".) A glass said to have night lenses is one having large objective lenses, allowing plenty of light. In the specifications on pages 39 and 40 you will find listed the percentage of light of each glass under the heading "Relative Brightness".

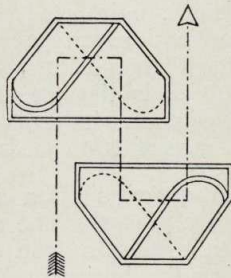
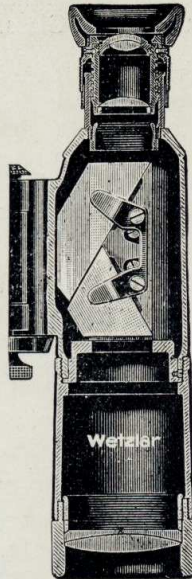
In the selection of a glass it is of the utmost importance to know the principal uses to which the glass will be put. For example, at the races, stadium, theatre and for indoor sport, a glass of large field and of low power is preferable. For the hunter and the tourist, a glass of medium power and light weight is most suitable. For yachting or use at sea, a medium power glass with plenty of relative brightness is advisable. For the mountains, astronomical use, the seashore or lakeside porch, glasses of high power are in favor. Here we might add that glasses exceeding 10-power should have a tripod or other solid support on account of the vibrations of the hand being greatly exaggerated by the high magnification.

It is here important to know that the U. S. Navy specifies 7 power as the maximum, consistently effective on the unsteady deck of a ship and the maximum power effective on misty days and at dawn and dusk.

A GOOD glass, properly chosen, and given the care due any precision instrument will last a lifetime. It is therefore vital when choosing a Field Glass or Binocular that you should be sure of the integrity of the house with whom you are dealing. Glasses of superior as well as inferior construction and optical qualities often have practically the same outward appearance. The expense in the manufacture of a glass is almost entirely made up by the quality of the optical glass used, and the skill and precision with which the lenses and prisms are ground and polished. Inferior material and workmanship are very difficult to detect in a new glass, but time will develop the defects such as cloudiness, double images, etc. The S. & A. trade-mark is your guarantee of satisfaction and accuracy.
